The show steward or judge may order any individual removed from the show grounds for inappropriate language, heckling, or other abuse shown toward the judge, an exhibitor, or horse. Any questions or concerns for the judge must be addressed to the show steward. Violators may receive a warning, suspension, or revocation of MWHA membership and/or showing privileges with MWHA.
